**DESIGNED FOR:** Personnel who need to be able to confidently and efficiently use Supplied Air Breathing Apparatus (SABA) for work in hazardous environments.

**PRE-REQUISITES:** None

**DESCRIPTION:** This course is highly practical in nature with brief theory sessions used to develop knowledge and understanding. The aim of this course is provide trainees with the knowledge and skills necessary to safely carry out work tasks using Supplied Air Breathing Apparatus (SABA).
