DESCRIPTION: This Unit of Competence covers the operational conditions in which a permit to work has been issued, and the required activities and functions associated with the production/process of chemical, hydrocarbons and oil products.

CONTENT: It is essential that competence be demonstrated throughout the duration of the course:

- Identify the importance of different work permits & carry out action specified in the permit
- Monitor and control multiple work permits & recognise deviations
- Apply OH&S and other appropriate procedures
- Take appropriate action to resolve faults or report faults to appropriate personnel
- Explain and implementing emergency procedures
- Timely and effectively use communication
- Follow safety procedures
