

OPITO BOSIET Bridging (TBOSIET upgrade to BOSIET)

COMMONLY KNOWN AS: BOSIET Bridging

DURATION: 1 day

PRICE: \$700 per person

DESIGNED FOR: Personnel who have previously undergone training to the OPITO TBOSIET/TFOET standard, who now require BOSIET to achieve the specific requirements for working in cold water areas such as the UK Continental Shelf operating area, or New Zealand.

PRE-REQUISITES: Current certification in TBOSIET or FOET.

DESCRIPTION: This bridging course is designed to address the different training requirements between the OPITO TBOSIET/TFOET and the UK BOSIET Standard. This course focuses on the training required for the UK Continental Shelf which is not addressed with the TBOSIET for example, wearing of survival suits & UK specific legislation.

CONTENT: It is essential that competence be demonstrated throughout the duration of the course.

Safety induction 100% theory:

- Industry overview and installation overview
- Offshore hazards
- Offshore environment
- Organisation for safety
- Safety management system
- Permit to work
- Living offshore
- Helicopter safety and escape – 40% theory 60% practical
- Helicopter travel
- Helicopter emergencies
- Helicopter safety and escape.

Sea survival 40% theory 60% practical:

- Evacuation and escape
- Firefighting and self rescue – 40% theory 60% practical
- Firefighting offshore
- Self rescue.

ASSESSMENT: Trainees will be assessed against the learning outcomes using direct observation; oral and/or written questions; possible use of a workbook; and practical exercises as appropriate.



CERTIFICATION: On successful completion trainees will be issued with a Statement of Attainment Basic Offshore Safety Induction and Emergency Training (BOSIET), and a BOSIET identity card.

In addition, this course also meets the requirements for the following National Units of Competency from the Chemical, Hydrocarbons & Oil Refining Training Package (PMA02) and the Asset Maintenance Training Package (PRM04). Successful completion of these Units of Competency will also be displayed on the certificate:

- PMAOHS214A Undertake Helicopter Safety and Escape
- PRMPFES05B Use Portable Fire Fighting Equipment

DELIVERY METHOD: 3 hours of classroom theory PowerPoint presentations, including audio-visual material, practical desktop activities and discussion.

5 hours of practical components using specialised equipment in a range of work simulated scenarios.

MEDICAL CLEARANCE REQUIRED: Trainees will be required to supply a completed medical clearance on their first day of training. This medical clearance must have been completed by a medical practitioner, within three months of the start of the course.

VALIDITY: This course is valid for four years from the date of your original TBOSIET certification. However, your specific company may require this course to be refreshed every two years (see FOET).
