

# PMAOHS213B Undertake Fire Control and Emergency Rescue



**DURATION:** 1 day

**DESIGNED FOR:** Personnel who are required to manage non-fire incidents (i.e. members of a site incident response team). An ability to work under supervision and/or alone is required.

**PRE-REQUISITES:** None

**ERGT PRE-REQUISITES:**

- MSAPMOHS216A Operate Breathing Apparatus for Emergency Response
- MSAPMOHS212A Undertake First Response to Fire Incidents

**DESCRIPTION:** In this Unit of Competency trainees demonstrate that they must be able to work alone and also within an environment which requires a high level of teamwork and interpersonal communication. A person undertaking this unit of competency should be able to respond to directives given either by emergency team leaders or other team members in order to contain and control the emergency.

**CONTENT:** It is essential that competence be demonstrated throughout the duration of the course:

- Work effectively in a team
- Recognise fire behaviour
- Demonstrate the impact of fire fighting tactics
- Conduct fire fighting operations in accordance with the organisation's safe work practices.

**ELEMENTS OF COMPETENCY:**

- PMAOHS213B/01 Respond to identified fire emergencies
- PMAOHS213B/02 Deploy fire emergency equipment
- PMAOHS213B/03 Undertake search of and rescue from affected areas

**ASSESSMENT:** Trainees learning outcomes will be assessed using direct observation, oral and/or written questions, and/or use of a workbook, and practical exercises as appropriate.

**CERTIFICATION:** On successful completion of this unit of competency trainees will be issued with a Statement of Attainment in PMAOHS213B Undertake Fire Control and Emergency Rescue.

**DELIVERY METHOD:** 3 hours of classroom theory PowerPoint presentations, including audio-visual material, desktop activities and discussion. 5 hours of practical components using fire fighting equipment in a range of work simulated scenarios.
