DESCRIPTION: This competency unit covers the identification, avoidance, review, and evaluation of workplace risks and hazards, maintenance of personal safety and the reporting to supervisors and team members.

CONTENT: It is essential that competence be demonstrated throughout the duration of the course:

- Correct identification of hazards in the workplace
- Application of organisational procedures including the correct selection and use of personal protective equipment (PPE)
- Advising and reporting workplace hazards in accordance with the organisation's requirements
- Notifying risks to a team and a supervisor in a timely manner.

ELEMENTS OF COMPETENCY:

- PUAFIR201B/01 Identify workplace hazards and risks and advise others
- PUAFIR201B/02 Implement hazard control procedures
- PUAFIR201B/03 Review effectiveness of hazard control procedures
