

WICOP Wine industry – Confined Space Awareness

DURATION: 0.5 to 1 day

PRICE: Group POA

DESIGNED FOR: Personnel who may come into contact with confined spaces in the workplace.

PRE-REQUISITES: None.

DESCRIPTION: ERGT recognised the need to deliver quality-training packages that meet the elements in the code of practice and assist the wine industry address its unique requirements and seasonal demands.

CONTENT: It is essential that competence be demonstrated throughout the duration of the course:

- Australian Standard AS2865-2001, legislation & guidelines for work in confined space
- Identification of confined spaces and their hazards
- Risk control procedures, JSA/JHA, and permit systems
- Preparation of confined space for safe entry
- Operation of gas detection & ventilation equipment
- Selection, use & maintenance of height safety equipment for vertical access & rescue
- Selection, use, and maintenance of respiratory protective equipment, including filter-type respirators & external air-supply (long-line)
- Basic emergency preparedness.

ASSESSMENT: Trainees will be judged against the learning outcomes using direct observation; oral and/or written questions; possible use of a workbook; and practical exercises as appropriate.

CERTIFICATION: On successful completion of this unit of competency trainees will be issued with a Certificate of Training in Confined Space Awareness.

DELIVERY METHOD: 3 hours of classroom theory PowerPoint presentations, including audio-visual material, practical desktop activities and discussion. 5 hours of practical components to familiarise Trainees with confined space equipment in a range of work simulated scenarios.
