

ERGT Australia's Breathing Apparatus Incident Response Course (**BA IR**) is designed for personnel who work with Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) or may be required to use the apparatus in a rescue situation. These environments include onshore and offshore locations, and where work is undertaken that requires entry to confined spaces or other hazardous environments.

The individuals attending the course are expected to be experienced workers in the resource industry with exposure to facility/company induction processes. They may hold roles within emergency response teams in volunteer organisations or as part of a designated role in an organisations' structure.
